 making them almost impossible to capsize.
- **Ease of Use**: Pedalling is intuitive and no balancing skills are required. If you can pedal a bike, you can operate a waterbike.
- Low Impact: Waterbiking is a low-impact activity, gentle on the joints, making it suitable for a wide range of fitness levels and physical abilities.

- Recumbent Waterbikes: We offer recumbent models that provide enhanced back support and a comfortable, stable riding position, which can be particularly beneficial for individuals with certain mobility needs.
- Tandem Waterbikes: For those who may require assistance or prefer to share the
 experience, our tandem waterbikes allow a support person or companion to ride
 along and assist with steering and pedalling if needed.
