





I have downloaded my ticket from the Confirmation Email received to my phone's wallet or I have the QR code




Before I go on my tour, I will need to complete the Terms and Conditions, by clicking on the Sign Waiver button on my Confirmation Email.




I need to arrive at my meeting point on time, 15mins prior to my tour time, ensuring I have used the restrooms nearby if needed and allowed enough time to find parking if required.


I can check my meeting point on my Confirmation Email and click the Get Directions button.
